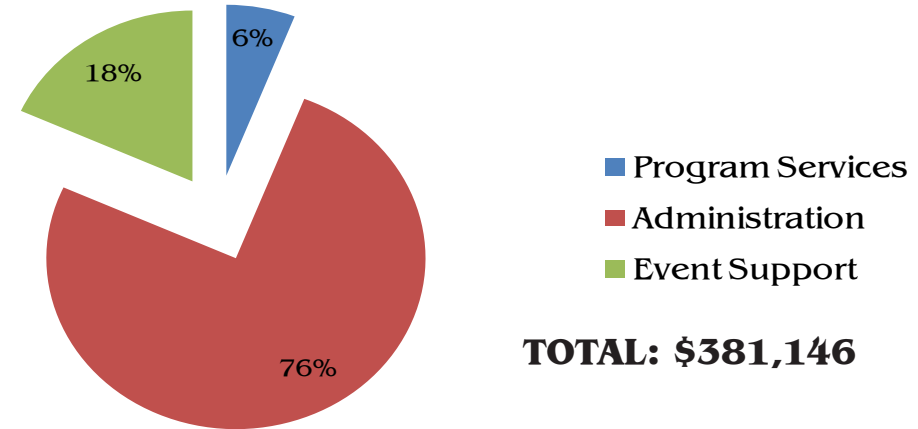

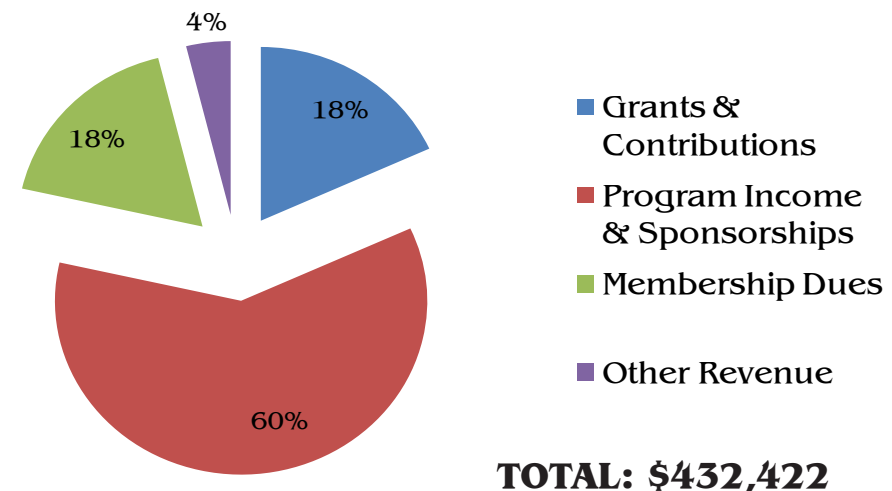

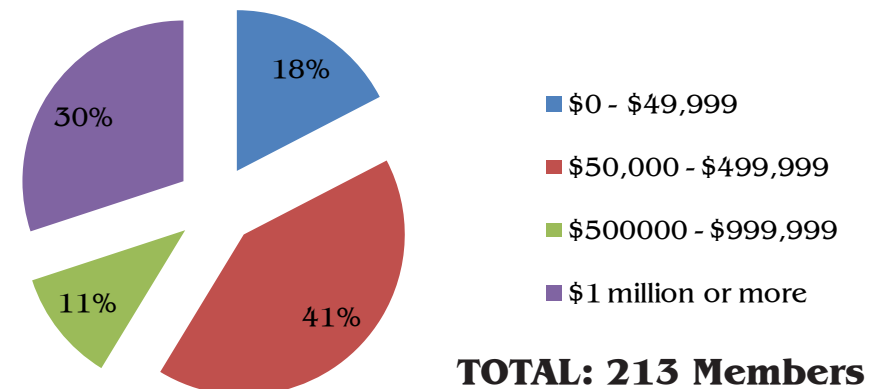
## Expenses
